On January 12, a magnitude 7.0 earthquake hit Haiti, devastating the capital city of Port-au-Prince. Millions were affected, and the death toll is expected to be in the thousands. Untold numbers of people were trapped as many buildings collapsed throughout the city. The United Methodist Committee on Relief (UMCOR) is responding to this disaster.

How can I help?

-Pray for everyone impacted by the earthquake and for those involved in disaster response.

-Make a monetary donation. 100% of money given to the Advance goes directly to the designated ministry.

1. Make check payable to your local church, and write "Haiti Emergency" and "Advance #418325" on the check. Put your check in the offering plate or give it to your church treasurer.
